

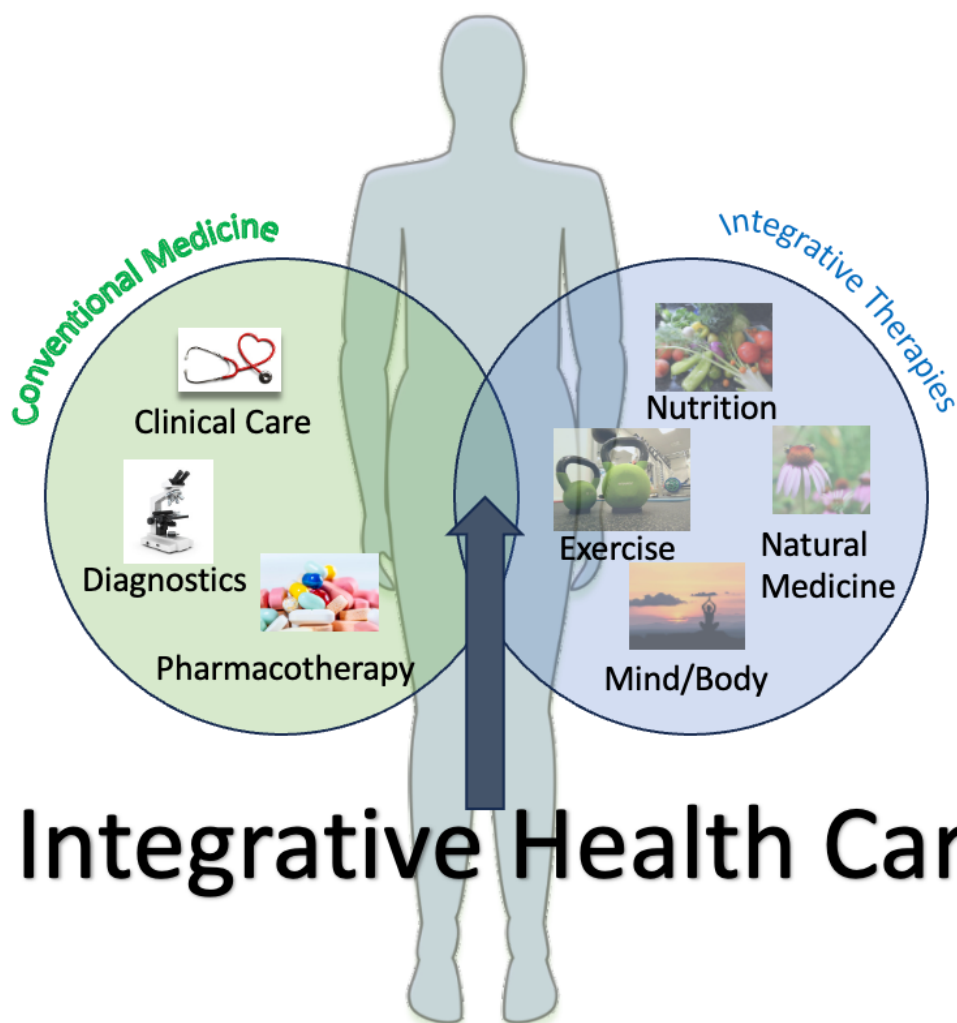

Tahitanga Health Centre Group is committed to expanding our community's Clinical Pathology Sector, founded in integrative health support and community conscious health foundations. **We are focused on strengthening access to healthcare for future generations,** building lasting community health resources, and creating pathways for education and wellbeing.

Our cornerstone vision is grounded in being a place for the community, by the community. We recognize that diagnostics are only one part of the healthcare journey, and that timely access to care, support, and follow-up services before, during, and after diagnosis is equally important.

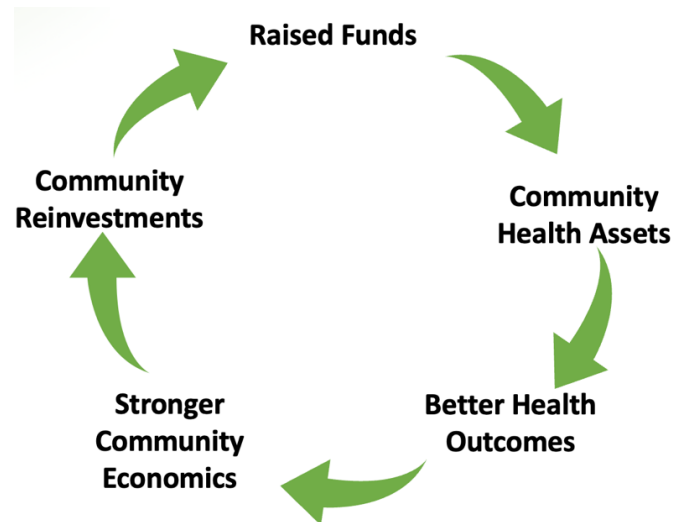

Our Opportunity for the Future

Our region has been presented with a valuable and rare opportunity to purchase a multi-purpose community health and medical property—anchored in connection with Tahitanga Health Centre. The construction of the Clinical Laboratory and ownership of the healthcare property extends our current community outreach and health support. We have secured the first \$10 million with the immediate asset acquisition with property purchase. We are reaching out to the community to support us, and in return support all of us!

We have secured an opportunity to purchase an established medical property with development opportunity to build out a Clinical Pathology Lab directly within the same local of a local/private hospital. The community ownership allows us to build the very first in New Zealand a **not-for-profit Clinical Pathology Laboratory**—a critical addition that will improve access to timely diagnostics and reinvest straight to the heart of community wellbeing, supporting better care, all closer to home.

This vision brings together both integrative and allopathic healthcare providers into a coordinated, collaborative environment, enhancing the very foundations of community health. Many of these providers are already established within the existing centre, and by working together more closely, we will create a truly connected model of care that supports a healthcare system currently under significant pressure.

We are now working to raise the remaining funding needed to make this vision a reality for everyone in our local community.

We have already secured \$10 million. **This ultimately is paid through the current tenants of the building, adding no extra cost, but a huge investment into our community.** Our goal is to raise the remaining \$10 million from a multi-faceted fundraising strategy. Time is of the essence, however we have established a relationship with the current owners and look forward to seeing this project develop.

Why This Matters

This project is about far more than buildings—it's about long-term impact.

- The facility will be owned by a community trust, ensuring it serves people—not profit
- It will bring together a wide network of healthcare providers working collaboratively
- A Clinical Pathology Laboratory will deliver essential diagnostic services locally and improve timely diagnostics and care pathways for Allopathic and Integrative Care
- All laboratory revenue will be reinvested into community healthcare
- The development includes capacity for future expansion as demand grows
- Over time, this will become a \$20–30 million community-owned health asset for the initial investment of \$10 million

This is a new model of care—community-led, integrated, and designed for long-term sustainability.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much of my donation goes directly to the project?

More than 95% of all funds raised go directly toward the purchase and development of the health facilities. Less than 5% supports essential planning and operational costs.

What if the funding goal is not reached?

If the purchase cannot be completed, donated funds will be returned to the community not-for-profit health sector, with a transparent process to determine next steps.

Are donations tax deductible?

Yes. Donations qualify for applicable tax credits, and official receipts will be provided.

This is our opportunity to take an active role in shaping the future of healthcare in Nelson Tasman.
